For ALL Students

- Fill out the **BLUE** Student Health Form - must be completed each year to provide essential health information about your child to the school nurses.
- Review the RHC School Based Health Center information
 - To enroll your child in the School Based Health Center: complete and return the **YELLOW** and **PINK** forms.

For Students with Asthma

- Asthma Action Plan completed by your child's primary care provider or the RHC.
- Medication Administration Form for albuterol to be given as needed for trouble breathing, completed by your child's primary care provider or the RHC.
- If/when in-person learning begins, bring an albuterol inhaler and spacer to the RHC. Your child's inhaler must have a spacer. We cannot accept nebulizers.

For Children with Food Allergies or Anaphylaxis

- Medication Administration Forms for diphenhydramine (Benadryl) and epinephrine auto-injector (EpiPen/EpiPen Jr.) completed by your child's primary care provider or the RHC. *Forms should include a list of specific allergies and reactions.*
- If/when in-person learning begins, bring a twin-pack of your child's auto-injector to the RHC.

For Children Taking Any Medication at School

- Medication Administration Form for the medication completed by your child's primary care provider or the RHC.
- If/when in-person learning begins, bring the medication in its original packaging to the RHC.

For Children Requiring Skilled Nursing Services at School (example: G-tube feeds, blood sugar checks, catheterizations, insulin administration)

- Talk with the school nurses to discuss your child's needs and receive specific forms.
- If/when in-person learning begins, bring supplies and information to the RHC.
